## Shiloh's BAD HABIT Tomboy's thumb-sucking worries Brad and Angie

**A**NGELINA JOLIE and Brad Pitt are desperate to break their daughter Shiloh of thumb-sucking because it can cause long-term emotional and physical problems. Shiloh, the couple's first-born biological child, turns 6 in May, and experts say she should have outgrown the habit long ago. **"BEYOND THE AGE OF 4,** thumb-sucking should be discouraged because it causes both physical and emotional damage," warned New York-based psychotherapist Dr. Gilda Carle. Major orthodontic problems are not unusual, according to another expert.

"Thumb-sucking can alter the shape of the mouth and affect the alignment of teeth," Los Angeles-based dental cosmetic surgeon Dr. Michael Kosdon told The ENQUIRER. "The end result can be difficulty chewing, speech abnormalities and an unattractive smile." If thumb-sucking continues after age 5, "you might want to have the child examined for emotional problems or anxiety disorders," Miami-based periodontist Dr. Peter Rubelman told The ENQUIRER. As The ENQUIRER has reported, Brad and Angelina have locked horns over how to deal with their tomboy daughter's

ways, and her finger fixation has become another concern. Shiloh has recently been photographed sucking her thumb in public, and they want it to end, said the source. "They're offering her big incentives to quit. Brad told Shiloh that he'd take her on a special daddy-daughter weeklong camping trip if she stops." That approach is just what experts suggest. Dr. Jay Carter, a noted Pennsylvania-based psychologist, told The ENQUIRER: "The cure seems to be a lot of love and affection along with guidance and a reward system and praise for success in stopping." **by LYNN ALLISON**
